Thus, by proclaiming a certain orientation of its foreign policy, the state thereby clearly defines the trends in the development of its domestic policy. Therefore, the solution to the problem of Ukraine's geopolitical and humanitarian orientation requires the development of a Ukrainian centric and worldview model that not only does not contradict the Eurocentric vision of the world, but also generally coincides with it, while maintaining its national peculiarity [2, p.81]

- to contribute, in cooperation with relevant partners, to the development of a capacity-building programme to ensure the preservation of movable, immovable and intangible cultural heritage threatened by the war,
- support the organisation and implementation of the initiatives of the 'Year of Culture of Ukraine in Europe', including with the participation of displaced persons from Ukraine, in the spirit of both the European Cultural Convention and the Council of Europe Framework Convention on the Value of Cultural Heritage for Society,
- promote the integration of heritage into reconstruction and development processes in order to meet the needs of the population after the war and provide Ukraine with the necessary assistance, using all opportunities provided by the Council of Europe conventions and the legal, regulatory and technical frameworks in the field of culture, creativity and cultural heritage,
- provide expert support in budgeting and creating models of financial support for cultural institutions in Ukraine based on European standards and practices,
- to strengthen the capacity of Ukrainian cultural institutions and individual artists who continue their activities in Ukraine,
- contribute to the development of the capacity of Ukrainian cultural managers (by providing professional training programmes for cultural managers).
- provide expert assessments and assistance in accounting for and assessing damage to cultural institutions,
- facilitate the implementation of joint creative projects between Ukrainian and European artists and cultural institutions [4, p. 16–17].

By unifying the above, it is advisable to recognise the main mechanism of Ukraine's integration into the pan-European humanitarian space. We believe that in the context of the current geopolitical and geo-economic challenges, this should strengthen Ukraine's position in Europe. Multisectoral humanitarian assistance is essential to address the needs of the host country and refugees.
